**HOW TO MARK YOUR BALLOT**


Use a dark ink pen.

To indicate your vote, you must completely blacken the Oval  to the left of your desired candidate's name or issue's response.

To vote for a candidate not on the ballot, you must completely blacken the Oval  to the left of the blank line and write in the name of the candidate in the space provided.

Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted.

**TO CORRECT A VOTE**

If you mark a candidate or response in error, please cross out the incorrectly voted Oval  and completely fill in the Oval for the correct candidate or response.

**PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY VOTING INSTRUCTIONS**

This ballot contains partisan offices and \*nonpartisan ballot measures. For the partisan offices, you may only vote for the candidates of one political party.

If you want to vote for a democratic candidate, vote the democratic section of the ballot and mark the DEMOCRATIC OATH on the ballot return envelope.

If you want to vote for a republican candidate, vote the republican section of the ballot and mark the REPUBLICAN OATH on the ballot return envelope.

Vote for nonpartisan ballot measures. These votes will be counted, even if you do not mark a political party on the ballot return envelope.

You may not vote for both parties or select both parties on the ballot return envelope.

\*Not all jurisdictions have nonpartisan measures.

TEKOA SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 265  
JOINT WITH SPOKANE COUNTY NO. 80

SPECIAL ELECTION - PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the Tekoa School District No. 265 joint with Spokane County No. 80 levy taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the District for support of the District's General Fund educational, maintenance and operational expenses as follows:

Levy in 2008 for collection in 2009, a levy rate of approximately \$5.90 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$290,000; and, levy in 2009 for collection in 2010, levy rate of approximately \$5.90 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$290,000.

Newport Consolidated Joint School District No. 56-415  
Replacement of Expiring Educational Programs and Operation Levy

The Board of Directors of Newport Consolidated Joint School District No. 56-415 adopted Resolution No. 2-2007-2008, concerning a proposition to maintain current educational programs and operation. The proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational programs and operation expenses:

For collection in 2009, a levy rate of approximately \$1.83488 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$1,013,400; For collection in 2010, a levy rate of approximately \$1.67232 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$1,062,160; and, For collection in 2011, a levy rate of approximately \$1.52611 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$1,114,690

as provided in Resolution 2-2007-2008. Should this proposition be approved?

Proposition No. 1

Spokane County Fire Protection District No. 9  
Replacement Maintenance and Operation Levy

The Board of Commissioners of Spokane County Fire Protection District No. 9 adopted Resolution No. 07-8 concerning a proposition to meet the District's maintenance and operation needs. This proposition would authorize the District to levy taxes, in place of an existing levy, upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's Expense Fund expenditures for maintenance, operations and emergency medical services as follows:

Levy in 2008 for collection in 2009, a levy rate of approximately \$1.28 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$4,878,200; and, levy in 2009 for collection in 2010, levy rate of approximately \$1.28 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide a levy amount of \$5,266,700.
